



### Easy Pineapple Chicken Allrecipes.com

3 Tbsp. soy sauce
3 Tbsp. olive oil, divided
1/2 tsp. paprika
Salt to taste
1 lb. boneless chicken breast, cut into strips

- 1 red bell pepper cubed
- 1 bunch green onions trimmed sliced
- 1-12oz. can pineapple chunks, drained juice reserved
- 1 Tbsp. cornstarch

Combine soy sauce, 2 Tbsp. olive oil, paprika and salt in a bowl. Add chicken strips and let marinate while preparing other ingredients. Heat remaining tablespoon of oil in a skillet or wok. Add bell pepper and stir fry for three minutes. Add green onion and cook for 2 more minutes. Remove chicken from marinade and add to the skillet. Cook until no longer pink in the middle, 10-15 minutes. Add pineapple chunks and cook for 2 minutes. Combine pineapple juice and cornstarch and add to the skillet and bring to a boil. Simmer until thickened, about 3 minutes.

## Spring Asparagus Prepared By Chef Rick Whiteman at a recent Lunch and Learn

1 1/2 lbs. asparagus cut in 2-inch pieces 2 small tomatoes cut in wedges	1/2 tsp. salt 1/2 tsp. paprika
1 Tbsp. cider vinegar	1/3 c. canola oil
3/4 tsp. Worcestershire sauce	1/3 c. sliced almonds, toasted
1/3 c. sugar	1/3 c. crumbled blue cheese, optional

In a large saucepan, bring 1 cup water to a boil. Add asparagus; cook covererd, until crisp-tender, 3-5 minutes. Drain; place in large bowl. Add tomatoes; cover and keep warm. Place vinegar, Worcestershire sauce, sugar, onion, salt and paprika in a blender. Cover and process until smooth. While processing, gradually add oil in a steady stream. Toss with tomatoes and asparagus. Top with almonds and blue cheese.
