Easy Baked Beans Submitted By: Corky Stevenson

4 slices bacon 1/2 c. chopped onion 2-16 oz. cans pork & beans 1/2 c. brown sugar 1/2 c. ketchup1 tsp. Worcestershire sauce1 tsp. prepared mustard

Preheat oven to 350. Combine all ingredients except bacon. Put into a baking dish and put bacon on top. Bake uncovered for 1 1/2– 1 3/4 hours, checking periodically. (If making a larger quantity, bake a little longer.) Add a little water if mixture becomes too dry. Let stand a few minutes before serving. Serves 4-6 (double or triple as needed)

Apple Pie Muffins Recipe From: All Recipes

2 1/4 c. all-purpose flour
1 tsp. baking soda
1/2 tsp. salt
1 egg
1 c. buttermilk
1/2 c. butter, melted
1 tsp. vanilla extract

1 1/2 c. packed brown sugar 2 c. diced apples 1/2 c. packed brown sugar 1/3 c. all-purpose flour 1 tsp. ground cinnamon 2 Tbsp. butter, melted

Preheat oven to 375. Grease a 12 cup muffin tin or line with paper muffin cups. In a large bowl, stir together 2 1/4 c. flour, baking soda, and salt. In a separate bowl, mix together the egg, buttermilk, 1/2 c. melted butter, vanilla and 1 1/2 c. brown sugar until sugar has dissolved. Pour into the flour mixture and sprinkle the diced apple into the bowl. Stir just until everything is blended. Spoon into the prepared muffin tin, filling cups to the top. In a small bowl, stir



together 1/2 c. brown sugar, 1/3 c. flour, and cinnamon. Drizzle in 2 Tbsp. of melted butter while tossing with a fork. Sprinkle over the tops of the muffins. Bake for 25 minutes, or until the tops of the muffins spring back when lightly pressed.
