Call us at 765-482-5220 or 317-873-8939. The Lebanon office is open **Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.**

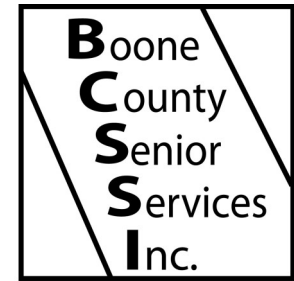

Personal Services

The BCSSI Personal Services Program is licensed through the Indiana State Department of Health and the Indiana Association of Home and Hospice Care.

Each client receives an individual in-home assessment for non-skilled care, including but not limited to:

- Light housekeeping
- Changing of bed linens
- Laundry
- Bathing assistance
- Dressing/Grooming assistance
- Light meal preparation
- Medication reminders and monitoring (with support from Drug Free Boone County)
- Grocery shopping
- Errands
- Respite Care
- Guardianship
This court-ordered service oversees the welfare and safety of the person under guardianship.

Transportation

Call to Schedule

BCSSI and Boone Area Transit System (BATS) provides transportation service to the general public in Boone County.

The demand-response program (including wheelchair transport) is available **5 days** a week between the hours of **7:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.** The service is available for destinations in Boone County and surrounding counties.

- **Senior (Over 60)**
Transportation for appointments, shopping, activities and more in Boone and surrounding counties.
- **Medicaid**—To schedule call Southeastrans at 1-855-325-7586 and request BCSSI as your provider.
- **Public (Under 60)**
Transportation anywhere in Boone and surrounding counties.

Transportation service is scheduled as availability permits; medical needs have first priority. Call for fee schedule.

Reservations must be made in advance by calling the agency. Next day reservations must be made by 1 p.m. and all reservations must be made by 4 p.m.
