

White Rotisserie Chicken Chili Recipe From thekitchn.com

2 Tbsp. Olive Oil
1 large onion, diced
2 cloves garlic, minced
6 c. low sodium chicken broth
Shredded meat from 1– 2lb. plain rotisserie chicken
2– 15 oz. cans white beans, rinsed & 2- 4 oz. cans diced green chiles
2 tsp. ground cumin
1 tsp. dried oregano
1 1/2 tsp. kosher salt
1/4 tsp. cayenne (optional)
1 lb. frozen corn kernels
Sour cream, diced avocado, crushed tortilla chips and cilantro for serving

In a large Dutch oven, heat olive oil over med-high heat until shimmering. Sauté onion until soft, about 5 mins. Add garlic and sauté 1 minute. Add chicken broth, chicken, beans, chiles, cumin, oregano, salt and cayenne. Simmer covered, 20 mins. Add corn and simmer until cooked through, about 1 minute more. Season to taste and serve with desired toppings.

Taco Pockets Recipe From foodnetwork.com

1 1/3 lb. ground sirloin

drained

- 1 small onion, finely chopped
- 2 cloves garlic, chopped
- 1 Tbsp. ground cumin
- 1 Tbsp. chili powder
- 1 tsp. salt
- 1 Tbsp. vegetable oil

- 4-12" soft flour tortillas
- 1 c. mild taco sauce
- 1 romaine heart, shredded
- 2 plum tomatoes, seeded and chopped
- 2 c. shredded Monterey jack cheese Mild Salsa

Combine meat, onion, garlic, spices and salt and form into four patties. Fry over medium-high heat in 1 Tbsp. oil for 7 minutes on each side. Heat a flour tortilla in a skillet and put on a plate. Spread with 1/4 c. taco sauce. Put lettuce, tomatoes and cheese in center of tortilla. Top with a burger patty. Wrap tortilla up and over patty on all four sides. Turn over and cut in half on the diagonal. Serve with Salsa.
