morning or are having a fabulous week, a near perfect month and feeling really good about yourself and then... the car won't start, you throw your back out, your password won't work to log in to an important web site so that you can pay a bill, your favorite neighbor just told you that they are moving to a different community, the grocery item that has become a staple in your cabinet is temporarily (will it ever be again?) unavailable. BCSSI Spotlight Cindy Elliott, Director of Transportation "Celebrating 24 Years of Service"

When Cindy Elliott found out about an opening with BCSSI for a receptionist position she had less than 24 hours to prepare a resume and



get it submitted to Founder and Executive Director Margot Corson before the application deadline. Cindy was looking for a new job and change. Little did she know, she was one of 52

applicants! With a successful interview demonstrating her organizational skills by scheduling a day of transit pick-ups, she was hired!

Cindy recalls a much smaller staff in the early years which consisted of Founder Margot Corson, Sue Ritz, Bonnie Fletcher, Myra Dearing and three paid drivers. The agency was located in the little blue house at 403 North Lebanon St. in Lebanon. The agency owned a purple van and two cars...much different than the 37 staff members of today and the 20 plus vehicles in current operation. When she started, all scheduling requests for transportation were directed to her and everything was completed by hand on paper, and using ticket stubs. Cindy not only handled the transportation scheduling but also payroll, accounts payable and receptionist duties.

Cindy recalls the biggest change over the many years at BCSSI has been converting everything to computers. Today, through the use of a computer scheduling system, transportation annually schedules between 17,000-24,000 trips with 700-1000 customers (numbers have varied due to Covid).

Cindy has enjoyed working with the different drivers over the years. "Being around great

people because they wanted to work and not because they had to work is special and I have become attached to many of our drivers over the years". Some of the past

drivers she recalls working with in her earlier years, include Hank Tallman, John Dotas, Russ Roberts and Paul Reagan, just to name a few. She



also recalls many volunteers such as George & Nancy Tikijian and Pat James that gave countless hours to help with transportation pick ups in Zionsville.

"It all started as a job that is now a big part of my life. I feel like I gave 100% and I am proud of my time with BCSSI. I will miss the people and staff. I am excited to retire and spend more time with family, travel, volunteering at church and not having to set my alarm for 4:30AM to get to the office".


Cindy considers herself a life-long resident

Spring Confetti Bars Recipe From chelseasmessyapron.com

12 Tbsp. unsalted butter, room temp.

1 c. granulated sugar

1/2 c. brown sugar, lightly packed

1 large egg

1 large egg yolk

2 tsp. vanilla

2 c. + 2 tbsp. flour

1/2 tsp. baking soda

1/2 tsp. salt

1 1/4 c. white chocolate chips, divided

3 c. miniature marshmallows

3/4 c. spring-colored m&ms

1-3 Tbsp. spring sprinkles

Heat oven to 350, spray a 9x13 pan with cooking spray and line with parchment paper. In a large bowl combine butter and sugars. Beat until light and creamy. Mix in egg, yolk, and vanilla until combined. In a separate bowl, stir together flour, baking soda, and salt. Stir into wet ingredients just until combined. Stir in 1 c. white chocolate chips. Spread into prepared pan and bake for 22-26 minutes until the top is no longer glossy and the edges are slightly browned. Top immediately with marshmallows and bake for 1 min and 30 seconds. Gently press down marshmallows and top with remaining chips, m&ms and sprinkles. Cool completely and cut with a hot, sharp knife. (Heat knife by running under hot water.)
