

- Participants must be 60 years old or over, or age 55 and over, disabled and living in senior housing with congregate nutrition services.


Caramel Pecan Buns Recipe Submitted By: Dennis Carrell

1 can Pillsbury Grands refrigerated cinnamon rolls

1 c. chopped pecans 1/4 c. packed brown sugar

2 Tbsp. butter

Bake cinnamon rolls as directed on package. Reserve icing. Melt butter in 10" skillet over medium heat; add pecans. Cook, stirring constantly 2-3 minutes or until butter just starts to brown. Add brown sugar. Cook, stirring constantly until the sugar melts and bubbles, about 2 mins. Spoon over buns when they are hot out of the oven. Remove cover from icing. Microwave on medium power 5-10 seconds or until thin enough to drizzle. Drizzle over warm buns. Serve warm. **Tip:** Pecans can burn easily and need to be closely watched as they cook.
