From the desk of our Executive Director Anita Bowen



Someone came into BCSSI recently and was upset that we don't do exercise classes as part of our programming. I went on to explain that we're not in the business of duplicating services/programs and, since we're on the same "campus" as the Witham Family YMCA and Witham

Health Services, both which offer an array of exercise options, we would not be offering them here. I was able to share that our Line Dancing classes (which occur twice monthly) actually get your heart pumping while also having fun. We do the Line Dancing because the YMCA and Witham do not. This encounter left me feeling thankful for the array of exercise opportunities located within our area and opportunities to share those even when they're not happening within the walls of BCSSI.

In another scenario recently, I fielded a concern about the Theater Thursday movie selections. I am the person who selects these movies each year, and I sure do try hard to choose a variety of movies for people from all different backgrounds and for all decades age 60+. 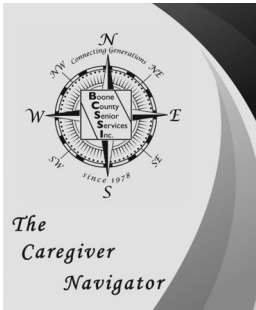

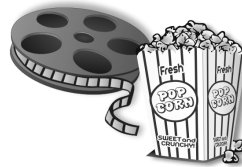

1Tbsp. vanilla extract

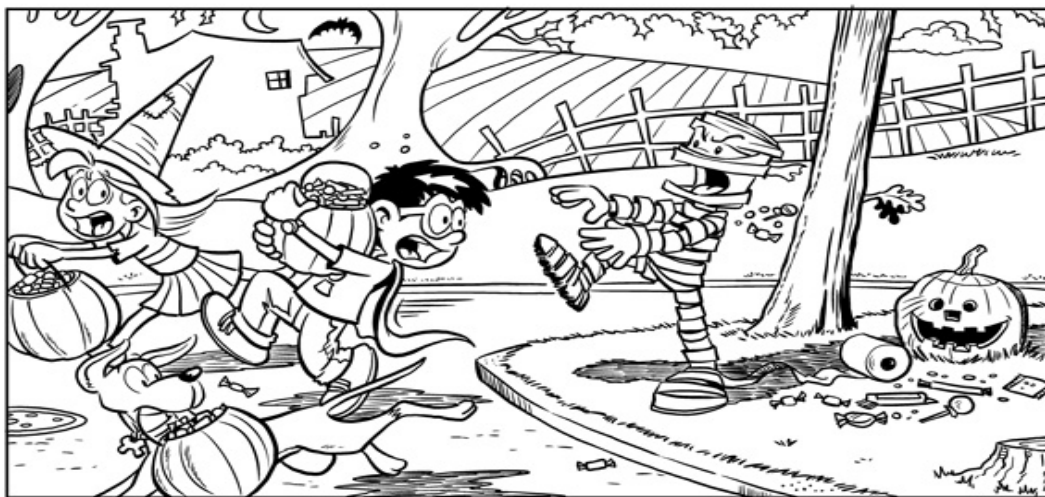
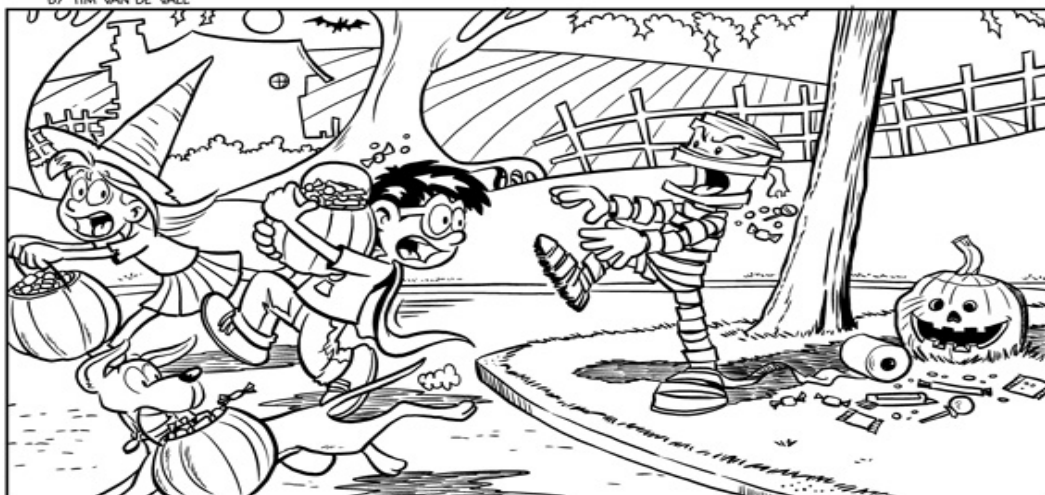

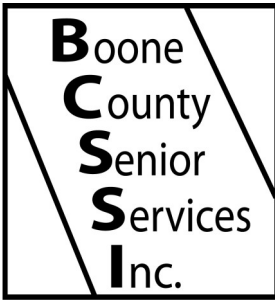
