



Veggie Tortellini Soup

8 c. low sodium vegetable or chicken stock

6 oz. tomato paste

1- 1lb. bag frozen mixed vegetables

10 oz. fresh cheese tortellini

1/2 c. heavy cream Salt and pepper to taste Fresh parsley, chopped Fresh basil, sliced thin

In a medium pot over medium-high heat, bring stock to a gentle boil. Stir in tomato paste. Add frozen vegetables and return to a gentle boil. Add the tortellini and cook for 3-5 mins. Add heavy cream and parsley and cook for 2 more minutes. Taste and adjust seasonings. Garnish with basil.
