

1 can refrigerated crescent dough 1/4c. apricot preserves

6 American cheese slices6 slices deli turkey breast


Heat oven to 350. Line 8x4 loaf pan with foil, extending ends over the sides. Spray with cooking spray. Unroll crescent dough onto lightly floured cutting board to form a 12x8 rectangle. Spread with preserves, completely covering the dough. Top evenly with cheese, cover with turkey. Cut dough lengthwise in half, then cut each piece crosswise into 6 pieces. Fold each piece crosswise in half. Stand, folded side down in a row in the center of the prepared pan. Bake 30-35 min. or until golden brown. Cool 10 min. Use foil handles to transfer loaf to serving plate. Remove foil and serve.
