




National Family Caregivers Month is celebrated each November and is a time to recognize and honor family caregivers across the country. This year's theme is #CaregiversConnect.


Celebrating Family Caregivers during National Family Caregivers Month enables all of us to:



Butternut Squash Soup

1 Tbsp. olive oil

1 onion, peeled & diced

4 cloves garlic, peeled & minced

2 c. vegetable broth

1 carrot, peeled & chopped

1 Granny Smith apple, cored & chopped

1 3-4lb. butternut squash, peeled & diced

1 sprig fresh sage 1/8 tsp. cayenne

Pinch of cinnamon & nutmeg

1/2 c. unsweetened coconut milk

Salt & pepper to taste

Optional toppings: nuts, crumbled

bacon, parmesan cheese, and/or greens

Heat oil in a large stockpot over med-high heat. Sauté onion until soft, add garlic and sauté for 1-2 more minutes. Add broth, carrot, apple, squash, sage, cayenne, cinnamon & nutmeg. Cook until soup reaches a simmer. Reduce heat to med-low, cover and cook 20-30 minutes until vegetables are tender and mash easily with a fork. Remove sage. Stir in coconut milk. Puree soup with an immersion blender until smooth. Serve with optional toppings if desired.
