Salad:

3 c. uncooked fusilli pasta
2 heaping cups halved cherry tomatoes
1 can chickpeas, drained & rinsed
2 c. arugula or fresh spinach
1 cucumber, quartered and sliced thin
1 c. crumbled feta cheese
1 c. fresh basil leaves, torn
1/2 c. minced fresh parsley
1/4 c. pine nuts, pepitas, or sunflower seeds

Dressing:

1/4 c. olive oil
3 Tbsp. fresh lemon juice
1 tsp. Dijon mustard
3 cloves garlic, minced
1 tsp. dried Italian seasoning
1/4 tsp. red pepper flakes
3/4 tsp. salt

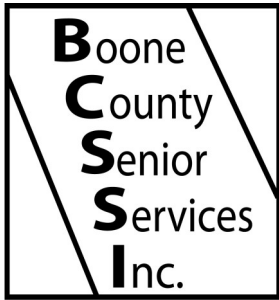
Bring a large pot of salted water to a boil and cook pasta according to package directions. Whisk together all dressing ingredients in a small bowl. Drain pasta and toss with a little olive oil.
