# Charitable Giving and the New Tax Code

The ombudsman budget bill signed by Congress this summer has embedded changes that will affect your charitable giving in 2026 and beyond. We all need to think about how, and when, to give to take advantage of federal income tax deductions for our good deeds. Here are some of the major points to consider for next year:

- Non-itemizers (roughly 90% of filers) will be able to deduct gifts up to \$1,000 as single filers or \$2,000 as couples filing jointly in 2026. **Tip:** remember to save your documentation of smaller gifts for 2026 - something you may have stopped doing these past years.
- If you itemize, a charitable deduction will only be available for total giving in excess of 0.5% of your Adjusted Gross Income (AGI). **Tip:** The concept of a “giving year” may make more sense under the new regulations. You may consider bunching multiple years of giving in one year to maximize tax benefits, then taking a year or years off.
- Individuals in the highest tax bracket (37%) will be limited to charitable deductions of only \$.35 per dollar given.

**Tip:** If you fall into this tax bracket, consider maximizing giving this year to take advantage of current giving rules.

Other snippets from the regulations:

- The current 2025 tax brackets are made permanent, so annual giving planning may be easier.
- The estate and gift tax exemption increases to \$15M per individual, \$30M per couple.
- The standard deduction for 2026 will be \$15,750 per individual filer and \$31,500 for a married couple filing jointly.
- The maximum yearly deduction limit for cash gifts is made permanent at 60% of AGI.


# No Bake Pumpkin Cheesecake

8 oz. cream cheese, softened  
1 c.+1 T. milk, divided  
1 T. granulated sugar  
1 tsp. vanilla extract  
8 oz. whipped topping  
1 graham cracker crust

15 oz. Pumpkin puree (1 can)  
2 boxes instant vanilla pudding mix  
(3.4 oz. each)  
1 tsp. cinnamon  
1 tsp. pumpkin pie spice

Beat together cream cheese, 1 T. milk and vanilla in a large bowl. Fold in half of the whipped topping. Spread in the graham cracker crust. Whisk together 1 c. milk, pudding mix and dry spices until creamy. Spread over the cream cheese layer. Top with the remaining whipped topping. Refrigerate at least 4 hours.
