





Raw Apple Cake

From: Marty Lane, BATS Driver

For the cake:

- 1/2 c. shortening or margarine
- 2 c. sugar
- 2 eggs
- 2 c. flour
- 1/2 tsp. salt
- 1 tsp. cinnamon
- 1 tsp. baking soda
- 4 c. peeled & sliced apples
- 3/4 c. chopped nuts

For the topping:

- 1 c. brown sugar
- 1 c. water
- 1/2 stick margarine
- 2 1/2 Tbsp. flour
- 1 tsp. vanilla



To make the cake: Cream together shortening, sugar and eggs. Sift dry ingredients and mix into the creamed mixture. Stir in apples and nuts. Pour batter into a greased 9x13 pan and bake at 350 for 40 mins. To make the topping: Cook all ingredients until thick. When cake is done, let set for 5 mins and then spread with hot topping.
