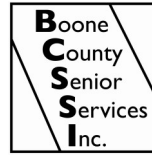

From the desk of our Executive Director Anita Bowen

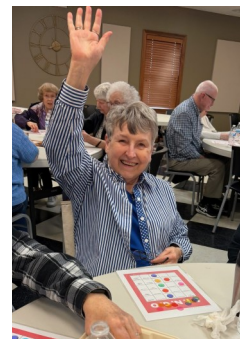

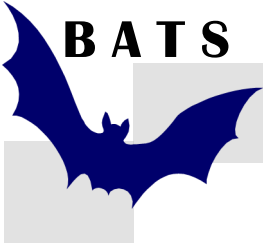

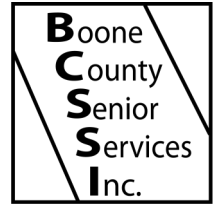

Pasta Primavera

From: Delish

12 oz. spaghetti	5 cloves garlic, finely chopped
1/4 c. extra virgin olive oil	1 c. grape tomatoes
1 large zucchini, sliced into half moons	3/4 c. heavy cream
1 bunch asparagus, trimmed and cut crosswise into pieces	1/3 c. frozen peas
1/2 red onion, sliced into half moons	2 oz. parmesan finely grated
2 small leeks, sliced into half moons	Lemon zest and juice from 1 small lemon, optional
1 red bell pepper, chopped	

Cook pasta according to package directions. Reserve 1 1/2-2 cups pasta water. Meanwhile, heat oil in a large skillet over medium high-heat. Cook zucchini 3-4 minutes. Add 1/2 tsp. salt and asparagus. Cook 4 minutes until vivid green and soft. and add 1/2 tsp. salt. Transfer vegetables to a plate. Reduce heat to medium. Add 1 tbsp of oil if needed and add onions and leeks and cook until soft and beginning to caramelize. Add 1 tsp. of salt. Add red pepper and cook until lightly softened. Add garlic and cook until fragrant. Reduce heat to medium-low. Add tomatoes, cream, peas and 1/2 cup pasta water. Cook until tomatoes are tender and beginning to burst. Add cooked vegetables, parmesan, spaghetti and a splash of pasta water and cook, tossing to combine, adding more pasta water as needed until sauce is glossy and cheese is melted. Stir in lemon zest and juice if using. Season with pepper.



FUN FLOWER FACTS



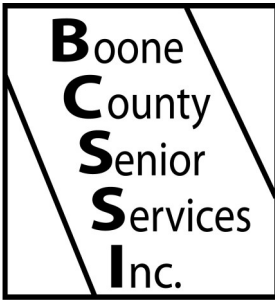
TULIPS WERE ONCE WORTH MORE THAN GOLD-Tulip mania was a real thing! Back in the 17th century, tulip bulbs in the Netherlands were wildly expensive. Some rare varieties went for more than houses! The market eventually crashed, but it shows how much people once valued these blooms.

SOME FLOWERS MOVE WITH THE SUN-It is real. This phenomenon, called heliotropism, is most known for sunflowers, but other blooms do it, too. The flower heads follow the sun's path across the sky during the day. At night, they reorient themselves to face east in anticipation of sunrise.
