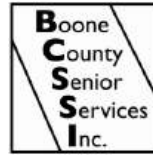

## From the desk of Jessica Evans, Director of Outreach

The morning after our Theater Thursday season opener (in May) featuring *Song Sung Blue*, a friend texted me a photo of her group. Looking at that picture instantly took me back to



everything I was feeling the day before.

As I reflected on the morning, a handful of moments kept coming back to me. It was so good to see many of our

caregivers there enjoying themselves with friends. A few readers of *Caregiver's Corner* introduced themselves, shared how much they enjoy the newsletter, and asked how both Mom and I are doing. Those conversations meant more than they probably realized.

Then there were friends of my Dad that I really only get to see during Theater Thursday season. Their hugs felt a little like getting a hug from Dad himself. Maybe it was because another anniversary of my sister's passing was just around the corner. Those hugs felt extra special that morning.



And then there was the music...

I couldn't help but sing along to a few of the songs, especially *Forever in Blue Jeans*. That was the one I used to sing with my dad when I was 12 or

maybe 13 years old, riding in the car together. For a few minutes, I wasn't sitting in a theater watching a movie...I was right back there with him. I honestly thought I was the only one singing along until someone stopped me and admitted he had been doing the same thing—

complete with the "touching hands" and fist-pumping through *Sweet Caroline*. It made me smile.

Several people also shared memories of attending Neil Diamond concerts years ago. You could see their faces light up as they relived those moments. Listening to their stories and seeing the twinkle in their eyes, I felt like I was traveling in a time machine right along with them.

Like Eric Church sings "*Funny how a melody sounds like a memory.*"

One of my favorite moments wasn't on the screen at all. I spotted two ladies together, one showing the other how to access *Senior Sounds* through our website. Such a simple interaction, but one that stood out to me.

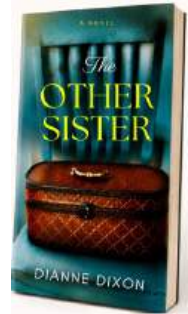

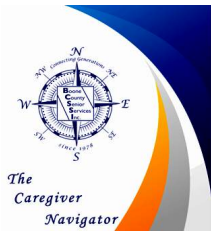
A 124-year-old patent filed by Seth Wheeler in 1891 (US Patent 465,588) shows toilet paper hung in the "over" position. The drawings in this, and a related 1871 patent, depict the paper hanging over the front of the roll rather than underneath, which is commonly cited as the "correct" way to reduce germ transfer as it keeps the roll from rubbing against the wall. As this patent was granted in 1891, it is long expired.

**How did you first learn about BCSSI?** My daughter found BCSSI online while searching for a home care organization to provide services for me after I had surgery in 2023.

**What activities and services have you attended or used?** During the past three years, I used three BCSSI services: home visits first by Susan, then by Maria; transportation

to and from doctors' appointments and to the airport. While I am a frequent international traveler, I have enjoyed the four domestic trips I have taken with BCSSI. After my first



BCSSI trip to Chicago, I recruited several of my college friends to join me on other trips, and they, too, have become regular BCSSI travelers. While

the transportation service is invaluable, I thoroughly enjoy the home care provided by Maria. She is outstanding!

**Why should others consider being involved with BCSSI activities and services?** BCSSI is an invaluable resource for Boone County seniors. I researched senior services in the surrounding counties and discovered that the volume and quality

What did you do before you retired?** I am a retired Vice President and Professor with 40 years of administrative and teaching service at universities in Toronto, Ontario, Canada, and Los Angeles, California. When I lost my husband, I sold our house in Redondo Beach, California, and built a house in Zionsville to be closer to my daughter. Since coming to Indiana, I developed and delivered a training program for the Zionsville Police Department and served the National Council of Negro Women by mentoring seventh-grade girls at Indianapolis Public School 43. **Any special activities and hobbies you enjoy?** My hobbies are organic gardening and international travel. I have traveled to 35 countries, gaining significant knowledge about cultures different from my own and learning, through the eyes of others, what it means to be American. 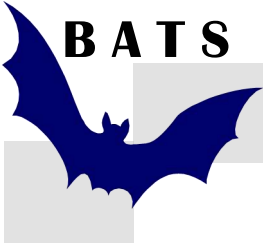

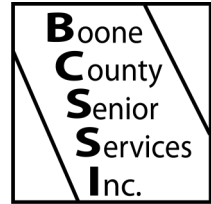

# Mixed Summer Berry Trifle

1 angel food cake cut into 1.5 inch cubes  
8 oz. Neufchatel, cream cheese or mascarpone  
1/2 c. granulated sugar  
1 tsp. vanilla extract  
1 Tbsp. lemon juice

2 lbs. strawberries, cut up  
6 oz. blackberries  
6 oz. raspberries  
3.4 oz. instant vanilla pudding mix  
2 c. cold milk  
8 oz. whipped topping or whipped cream

Whisk pudding mix and milk in a medium bowl for two minutes. Refrigerate for 5 minutes. Beat Neufchatel, sugar, vanilla and lemon juice with a mixer until combined. Make sure your berries are completely dry before you assemble the trifle. Arrange 1/2 the cake cubes in the bottom of your container. Arrange 1/3 of the berries in one layer. Top with half of the Neufchatel mixture and spread into an even layer. Add half of the pudding and spread into an even layer. Repeat layers. Top with the remaining berries. Top with whipped topping and additional berries and mint if desired.
